**Recommendation of the Executive Secretary**

$(\$6,560 - \text{EFC}) \times 27.44\% = \text{Award}$

$(\text{Student Budget} - \text{Expected Family Contribution}) \times \text{Student Award Percentage} = \text{Award}$

Maximum Award: \$1,800     Minimum Award: \$250

**2009-2010 Appropriation: \$432,500<sup>1</sup> per Governor's budget and subject to change**

**2008-2009 Appropriation: \$424,000**

**2007-2008 Appropriation: \$414,000**

**2006-2007 Appropriation: \$404,000**

**Current Formula:**

$(\$6,560 - \text{EFC}) \times 27.44\% = \text{Award}$

$(\text{Student Budget} - \text{Expected Family Contribution}) \times \text{Student Award Percentage} = \text{Award}$

Maximum Award: \$1,800     Minimum Award: \$250

**Current Year Spending:** All of the 2008-2009 funds will be spent.

**Applicants:** As of February 17, 2009 there are 1129 WHEG Tribal applicants compared to 1068 at this time last year. For all sectors there are 252,124 applicants for 08-09 compared to 234,849 for 0708 applicants at the same time last year.
