LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON REVIEW OF HIGHER EDUCATION FINANCIAL AID PROGRAMS

The Special Committee is directed to review current laws relating to financial aid for higher education in order to improve student access to higher education, maximize utilization of higher education resources, and retain qualified graduates in Wisconsin. Policies for review may include: (a) the Wisconsin Covenant; (b) loan forgiveness programs; (c) Wisconsin/Minnesota tuition reciprocity; (d) academic excellence scholarships; and (e) need-based grants and loans. Several financial aid directors are members of this committee including: Mary Jo Green, Jane Hojan-Clark, Louise Jahnke, and Paul Watson. Rolf Wegenke and Amy Kerwin are also members. I attend all meetings on behalf of HEAB as a resource person.
