The four higher education sectors in Wisconsin include the Independent Colleges and Universities, the Tribal Colleges, the University of Wisconsin System, and the Wisconsin Technical College System.







2007-08 Average Cost of Education / Need-Based Financial Assistance




2007-08 FAFSA Applicants Expected Family Contribution (EFC) Comparison

2007-08 Dependency Status of Need-Based Aid Recipients



2007-08 Number of Wisconsin Residents who Applied for and Received Need-Based Aid








10-Year Percentage of Need-Based Financial Assistance






