
Timeline

Environments

Environment	Availability	Purpose
Test / UAT	Used for testing.	This will be the testing environment after the production go-live for grants.
Beta	Until late June 2025.	 This is an environment for schools to use the full functionality of GLASS on a daily basis before the production go-live. On or before June 30th, 2025, beta will become the production environment. Important: 1. When beta becomes production, you will need to go through the same ID approval as with rebuilds in beta. 2. After beta becomes the production environment, any further testing will be performed in the Test / UAT environment. Watch for communications from HEAB. These communications will notify you of changes to the beta/production environment.

Training Scope: Grants

Wisconsin Grant - UW, Tech & Tribal

The Wisconsin Grant (WG) Program provides grant assistance to undergraduate, Wisconsin residents enrolled at least half-time in degree or certificate programs at University of Wisconsin, Wisconsin Technical College, and Tribal institutions.

Wisconsin Grant - Private Non-Profit

The Wisconsin Grant (WG-PNP) Program provides grant assistance to undergraduate, Wisconsin residents enrolled at least half-time in degree or certificate programs at non-profit, independent colleges or universities based in Wisconsin. Awards are based on financial need and partially based on that portion of tuition in excess of UW - Madison tuition.

Talent Incentive Program Grant

The Talent Incentive Program (TIP) Grant provides grant assistance to the most financially needy and educationally disadvantaged Wisconsin resident students attending colleges and universities in the State of Wisconsin.

Indian Student Assistance Grant

Awards under this program are made to Wisconsin residents who are at least 25% Native American and are undergraduate or graduate students enrolled in degree or certificate programs at University of Wisconsin, Wisconsin Technical College, independent colleges and universities, tribal colleges, or proprietary institutions based in Wisconsin.

Minority Undergraduate Retention Grant

Awards under this program are made to Wisconsin resident minority undergraduates, excluding first year students, enrolled at least half-time in independent, tribal, or Wisconsin Technical College institutions. According to the statutes, a minority student is defined as a student who is either an African American; American Indian; Hispanic; or Southeast Asian from Laos, Cambodia, or Vietnam admitted to the U. S. after December 31, 1975.

Hearing/Visually Handicapped Student Grant



Hearing/Visually Impaired Student Grant Program was established to provide funding for undergraduate Wisconsin residents, enrolled at in-state or eligible out-of-state public or private.

Scholarships

WI Higher Educational Aids Board - Academic Excellence Scholarship

Academic Excellence Scholarships (AES) are awarded to Wisconsin high school seniors who have the highest-grade point average (GPA) in each public and private high school throughout the State of Wisconsin.

WI Higher Educational Aids Board - Technical Excellence Scholarship

Technical Excellence Scholarships (TES) is awarded by the State of Wisconsin to Wisconsin high school seniors who have the highest demonstrated level of proficiency in technical education subjects.




Student Search



Search Student — Step 1


Go to home page then either (1) select **Search for Student** or (2) use the **Search field** along the menu bar near the top of the page and then click **Go**.

You will see a page like the below.





After you have selected a student from the search functionality, you will see the *Edit Student* page.






Payment Requests

Either select all check box at top to select all lines.




Or select individual line items.






Click on the *Request Payment* button.







Once you select *Request Payment*, you will see the below message.





Go to home page then select *Rosters*.








Rosters – Step 2



Go to home page then select **Standard Reports**.




On the page that appears (see below), click on the report box dropdown.

Then choose a report (for example, the *Award Disbursement Summary Report*). Some of reports require a few parameters to be selected/filled out.




