Beta	Refer to Timeline; Grants, Scholarships and Loans deployed into Beta on different dates.	This is an environment for schools to use full functionality on a daily basis before the production go-lives.

## **Grants**

### Wisconsin Grant - UW, Tech & Tribal

The Wisconsin Grant (WG) Program provides grant assistance to undergraduate, Wisconsin residents enrolled at least half-time in degree or certificate programs at University of Wisconsin, Wisconsin Technical College, and Tribal institutions.

### Wisconsin Grant - Private Non-Profit

The Wisconsin Grant (WG-PNP) Program provides grant assistance to undergraduate, Wisconsin residents enrolled at least half-time in degree or certificate programs at non-profit, independent colleges or universities based in Wisconsin. Awards are based on financial need and partially based on that portion of tuition in excess of UW - Madison tuition.






