# **Board Adopts 11-12 Formulas**

At its meeting on Thursday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, the Higher Educational Aids Board adopted the following formulas for 2011-2012:

#### WHEG - TRIBAL

No change to current formula

 $(\$6,560 - EFC) \times 27.44\% = Award$ 

Maximum Award: \$1,800 Minimum Award: \$250

#### WHEG - WTC

No change to current formula

 $(\$9,270 - EFC) \times 13\% = Award$ 

Maximum Award: \$1,205 Minimum Award: \$529

# WHEG - UW

 $(\$5,960 - EFC) \times 41\% = Award$ 

Maximum Award: \$2,444 Minimum Award: \$804

#### **Tuition Grant**

Maximum award: \$2,900 Minimum award: \$1,000

Inflation Factors: Dependent 340% Independent 740%

UW-Madison Tuition: \$9,515
Base Maintenance: \$10,800

The formulas are based on appropriation recommendations of Governor Walker and are subject to change if the approved budget so requires.
