Second semester voucher requests and refunds

Social Security Numbers

Beginning with the 13-14 academic year, HEAB is loading only those ISIR's with a perfect SSA match flag of "4" in order to reduce the SSN problems of the last few years. Although we are trying to keep our records from being overwritten this problem can still occur.

We would like to recommend that students who have filed with an incorrect SSN re-file under their correct social security number and **NOT** make a correction to the existing record in order to prevent this problem.

Covenant Grant Program Update

Please review your 13-14 notification lists to make sure that you have added the Covenant grant to eligible students' financial aid packages. Also, please check any transfer students that may be eligible.

Website and database administrator/TIP grant
