## **Covenant Grant Program Update**

Just a reminder to review your notification lists to make sure that you have requested the covenant and foundation funds, especially the transfer students.

As a reminder:

- The list of students who signed the WI Covenant Pledge should **not** be used to award students
- HEAB advises against awarding students based on this list and
- Using this list to early award students has only caused problems for HEAB <u>AND</u> the school involved in early awarding

## **Board Adopts 14-15 Formulas**

At its meeting on Friday, February 14<sup>th</sup>, the Higher Educational Aids Board adopted the following formulas for 2014-2015:

WHEG – TRIBAL<br/>No change to current formula<br/>(\$6,560 - EFC) x 27.44% = Award<br/>Maximum Award: \$1,800 Minimum Award: \$250WHEG – WTC<br/>(\$9,270 - EFC) x 11.70% = Award<br/>Maximum Award: \$1,084 Minimum Award: \$500WHEG – UW<br/>(\$5,960 - EFC) x 39% = Award<br/>Maximum Award: \$2,324 Minimum Award: \$764Tuition Grant<br/>Maximum award: \$2,900

Minimum award: **\$1,000** Inflation Factors: Dependent **340%** UW-Madison Tuition: **\$10,402** Base Maintenance: **\$8,500** 

Independent 740%

## TIP VOUCHERING SUSPENDED

Because of the high volume of continuing TIP students this academic year we are over committed in TIP funding. Unfortunately, because of the high volume we are not able to accommodate any TIP nominations that were received after the deadline of February 14, 2014. We are also not able to honor any reallocation of TIP funds. This means that if you had a student that you nominated and that student is no longer eligible you will not be able to reallocate those funds to another student. Cassie has sent out a request to the schools with a plan of how we are going to honor the committed awards. We are expecting a response from the schools by April 2, 2014.
